<b>January/February 2026</b>	Receive email with information about filling out application and completing paperwork through Managed Missions.

<b>June 1, 2026</b>	\$500 due to TBMB

<b>August 1, 2026</b>	Remaining balance to TBMB (*\$500 or \$850, if single room requested) All paperwork and background checks must be completed.
<b>August 21, 2026</b>	Orientation on Friday morning at TMC Retreat at Linden Valley Baptist Conference Center
<b>September 27, 2026</b>	Depart for Germany!

*\*\* Debit/Credit card payment (after initial deposit) will be available to pay via Managed Missions. There will be a small fee using a debit/credit card (please note that if you do not pay the fee, the fee will be taken out automatically from any money you are paying online), if using electronic check there is no fee.*

# Germany

## F.A.Q's

**Who will we be working with?** Bonn Bible Seminary

**What will we be doing?** We will be doing ministry concerts, community building with local worship pastors, collaboration with seminary students.

**Travel:** in and out of Frankfurt

**Cost:** Estimated all-inclusive cost for trip is \$3500 (double room) or \$3850 (single room). This cost includes airfare, room and board, meals while in Germany, ground transportation, required IMB insurance, and required background check. Cost **DOES NOT include** passport, passport photos, meals to and from Guatemala, snacks, baggage fees, souvenirs.

### **Managed Missions:**

- All of our paperwork will be online through Managed Missions. You will be sent a link to a Germany application once your registration is received. **It is important that you complete the application in a timely manner.**
- Managed Missions will have all the forms that you will need to fill out. Ministry Covenant and Release form will be sent to you automatically to fill out and sign.

### **Background checks:**

- Everyone over the age of 18 will be required to complete a background check. You will receive an email from Janis Hunley (or Clearstar) with a link to complete your background check online closer to trip time. Please complete this ASAP. If this is not completed, then you will not be able to participate in this trip.

**What about the language barrier?** German is the primary language. There will be translators.

**Will I receive any training prior to going?** Yes. Orientation will be on Friday, August 21 during TMC Retreat at Linden Valley Baptist Conference Center

## Proposed Fundraising Strategy

### **Germany Mission Trip 2026**

Here is a simple proven strategy that has helped other groups. We recommend your church set up an account for you. Ask all contributors to make checks out to the church and write the individual name on the memo line.

Enlist contributors to give \$20.00 per month for 10 months \$20.00 x 10 months=\$200 x 10 contributors=\$2000	\$2000.00
Personal contribution from participant	<u>1500.00</u>
Estimated total all-inclusive cost for trip.	\$3500.00

If you choose a single room, then the cost will change to \$3850

Fundraising ideas:

- Ask your church to partner by paying your \$500.00 deposit
- Enlist Family Members to contribute toward a Life-Changing Missions Experience
- Setup an online giving portal and share your story
- Ask your church to Sponsor you as a Missionary from the congregation
- Contact your local association and inquire about scholarships for people going on a mission trip

Cost **does not include** passport, passport photos, snacks, meals to and from Germany, baggage fees and souvenirs.
