Dr. Alexandra G. Arnold, a native of Laurel, MS, is an assistant professor of music and the recruitment and enrollment specialist at William Carey University. Dr. Arnold is the director of Carey's a cappella group, Carey On, an ensemble that specializes in pop/contemporary genres and performs secular and religious music throughout the Southeastern United States. She teaches many choral music ed courses at the undergraduate and graduate level. Dr. Arnold also has a voice studio where she instructs students in developing technique through a variety of repertoires. Following the slogan, “One goal, one passion” for the Winter’s School of Music at William Carey University, Dr. Arnold fully believes that her one goal is excellence in education and performance, but her one PASSION is Jesus Christ! Phil. 4:8

Dr. Arnold is a member of First Baptist Church of Laurel, MS, where she has served as the interim director of worship, and currently directs children’s choir, facilitates the music of VBS, and sits on the personnel and children’s committees. She currently lives in Ellisville with her husband, Todd, and two beautiful daughters, Lila and Collier.

Rebekah Feldman is the worship ministry associate at First Baptist Church of Morristown, TN. She assists in leading and planning worship services at FBCM. Rebekah also leads the youth praise band and accompanies the youth choir. She teaches piano, voice, and banjo. She completed her bachelor's degree in church music at Carson-Newman in 2023 and William Carey University with a Master of Music degree in Worship Studies in 2025.

Mac Duren is a rising Christian worship leader, musician, and arranger known for his work with First Baptist Church in Laurel, MS and for his studies at William Carey University's worship leadership program, blending modern worship with traditional elements, often featured with the First Dallas Choir & Orchestra on songs like "The Lord Our God" and "Greatest Praise," and creating his own choral arrangements for ministry.

Dr. Chris Headley brings nearly three decades of worship leading experience to Carson-Newman as an Associate Professor, Director of Worship Leadership, and Chair of the Department of Music. His commitment to the theological study of worship led him to The Robert E. Webber Institute of Worship Studies where he studied with faculty that included Dr. Lester Ruth, Dr. Andrew Hill, and Dr. Constance Cherry.

Kyle Hankins has lived in Nashville since the fall of 1985 where he attended Belmont University earning the Bachelor of Music Degree in Theory and Composition. He is pianist at Nashville First Baptist Church and serves as Liturgical Musician at Pope John Paul II High School. Kyle is accompanist for the Touring Choir for the Nashville Children's Choir Program and has served as organist for the Nashville Predators, playing at Bridgestone Arena in Nashville since 2002.
